Diversity In Action  
OCN Level 2  
(Training for Trainers)

Equips teachers to deliver a programme which gives young adults an opportunity to explore the issues around diversity.

ABC: Promoting an  
Anti-Bias Approach in  
Education  
OCN Level 3

Helps teachers gain an understanding of how to embed anti-bias practice in the school environment and encourage others to do the same. As signposted in the CRED policy as good practice, this training involves creating a welcoming and inclusive environment which promotes equality in terms of ethnicity, religion, gender, ability, sexual orientation and socio economic background.

Bespoke Anti-Bias Training

Short taster sessions that allow staff to explore the themes of anti-bias. This gives staff an opportunity to reflect on the issues addressed and to help them in developing an anti-bias approach.

Peer Mediation  
(Training for Trainers)

Brings staff through the Peer Mediation programme and allows them to explore the role that pupils can play in conflict resolution.

Whole school /partnership  
visioning

Facilitates the school (s) in the creation of a vision. This training brings the school communities through a process of reflecting on current Shared Education good practice and exploring areas that they would like to develop.

Addressing contentious  
issues

Bespoke workshops for staff looking at various contentious issues that are relevant to the time or school communities e.g.

- Sectarian bullying
- Symbols and emblems
- Events
- Local unrest
