The Nansen Dialogue Centre Osijek is pleased to invite you to the international conference “**Integrated and Intercultural Education in Europe**” that will take place from **February 28th till March 1st in Hotel Lav in Vukovar.**

The conference is organized within the project “Intercultural Education for Integrated Communities” that is implemented in partnership with the Open Academy Step by Step from Zagreb and in cooperation with the Faculty for Teacher Education of the J. J. Strossmayer University in Osijek. The project is funded by the European Union and the Government of the Republic of Croatia - Office for Cooperation with NGOs.

The main goal of the conference is to initiate a dialogue on intercultural education today and on the challenges and positive practices in its implementation. The conference is intended for primary and secondary school teachers, principles, pedagogues and other expert associates, representatives of civil society organizations and governmental institutions involved in education of children and youth. The conference will host guests from United Kingdom, Macedonia, Germany, Norway, Turkey, Israel, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Serbia and Croatia who will speak on these topics.

The conference is organized in three panel discussions with introductory presentations.

The topic of the first panel “*Integrated Education in Post-conflict Societies*” intends to introduce practices and models of integrated education after conflicts, as well as the importance and role of the same in the social reconstruction of the community.

The second panel with the topic “*Diversity and Inclusion in European Schools*” aims at showing the challenges and examples from the practice of different European models of intercultural education and its role in the education system.

The third panel “*A Framework for Intercultural Education in Croatia and Countries of the Region*” focuses on the local context of the region and will show good practice examples from Croatia, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Serbia.
