Cliftonville gained Integrated status in 2008 and since then the enrolment has improved by more than 50%. In 2008 there were 168 children in P1-7 and now there are 306 and an additional 26 places in the Nursery.

The school offers a teaching and learning environment where all religions, traditions and cultures are respected and nurtured together. In Cliftonville, it is our aim to provide an opportunity for each child to make the most of his or her ability.

The school offers a caring and friendly atmosphere within a disciplined framework, so that all pupils may reap the maximum benefit from their educational opportunities. Since the transformation to Integration the school enhanced its facilities through increasing support from parents and supporters of integrated education, and through the IEF.



We now have state of the art outdoor play equipment, iPads are used extensively throughout the school to enhance online programmes which include Accelerated Reading and Mathletics.

Integration has been a journey and a learning process which staff and pupils have benefited from greatly. The staff and Governors are very optimistic about the future of the school and they welcome the demand for Integrated Education in North Belfast. They are proud of the multi-cultural aspect of the school, with more than twelve countries represented in our school population.
